

## **New hole pattern for 2004 Connelly Skis!**

For the first time since 1965 Connelly plate bindings have a new hole pattern. The new hole pattern only affects ski bindings on metal base plates.

**What:** Plate bindings with the new hardware and plate system are 2004 Visions, Stokers and Front Adjustable Plates.

**When:** All metal baseplate bindings for 2004 product have the “new” hardware and baseplate. Pre-04 bindings have the “old” hardware and baseplate.

**Why:** The new bindings have side-mount hardware and shorter metal baseplates. This new system allows for a wider footbed area at the plate rather than the narrower design that fit in between our old hole pattern. The wider 2004 system delivers a more comfortable skiing experience for everyone whether you have wide feet or not. This new system allowed us to shave a couple inches of metal baseplate off the old system. The shorter plate combined with the new side-mount hardware makes the 2004 bindings look sleek.

Another feature is our hole pattern interchanges with both HO and KD front bindings. If you have ever wanted to try a World Record Holding slalom ski (F1 1@43 off, Jamie Beauchesne) but are stuck on your old HO or KD binding, we just made it easier to make the transition.

### **What if FAQ:**

Q - I have a 2003 or older Connelly plate binding that is in perfect condition and I love my binding, but want to buy an 2004 ski. What is the solution?

A – No problem, all 2004 skis have resin pockets for both the 2003 & 2004 hole patterns. That means there is additional resin in any area you will be inserting a screw or an insert so both will be secure.

Q – I want the all new 2004 Vision or Stoker binding, but would like to mount it on my 2003 or older ski. What is the solution?

A – No problem, all you need to do is purchase a conversion plate that transforms a 2004 binding into a 2003 hole pattern.

Q – What about rear bindings, did the hole pattern change?

A – Yes the hole pattern on the rear is new.

Q – Does the new 2004 Connelly rear hole pattern interchange with brand X?

A – No, each waterski company has its own unique rear hole pattern.
